


Characteristics of the servant is a DNA that is built & sourced from:

To the children who we love as sons and daughters of God




What Should the lesson be on ?

You should have a syllabus or agreed lesson structure / plan with your lead servant or fellow servants that builds to feed the group or is in sync with the spiritual year.




Preparation

The first part of preparation is prayer .


If the source is not the Lord, our lesson is futile.

Sound Doctrine

"IN YOUR DOCTRINE SHOW...SOUNDNESS OF SPEECH THAT CANNOT BE CONDEMNED" TITUS 2:7-8



Many of our youth are in serious danger from incorrect and subtle teaching in media and school and friends

1 Timothy 4:6-16 "Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you." v.16








Every lesson should be sourced in the word and have quotations from the Holy Bible Our Lord Jesus Christ started His service concentrating on sound doctrine in The temptation on the mount.

He answered each of the devil's temptations with a verse from the Holy Bible.



The devil can use the very words of the Holy Bible and twist them. "In their hands they shall bear you up Lest you dash your foot against the stone" Matt 4:6. If only the devil continued... "You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample under foot" Ps91:13.
