
### Martyrs then the Golden 4<sup>th</sup> Century



- The town is named after St Maurice

- Our unified language is the quote from Tertullian

- I noticed St Bahnam and his sister in the Commemoration of saints, doesn't sound Greek name
- He was a son of the Persian King, also converted to Christianity
- The king killed him and his sister
- The blood of the martyrs is the seed of Christianity
- Let St Behnam rejoice at the ½ million converts from Islam in Iran , the real figure is likely much bigger- John can advise



Arius was a clever priest in Alexandria, taught that the Son is not equal to the Father, but because Jesus was perfect on earth, he is a model for people to imitate him, by their own effort

- So, Jesus does not give grace, it is all human effort
- Pope Alexandros : how could God be the Father without the Son being there, co eternally

But Jesus is the son by nature, we are sons by adoption only through the grace of Jesus Arius still exists in Jehova's witnesses and in Islam The root of them is that Jesus was great but is not equal to the Father


#### Pope Athanasius




## Faced with difficult challenges, what moniq hon qo ss

 Pope Athanasius, Contra Mundum
 Spent 23 yrs in exile, the emperor became Arian, and persecuted Pope Athanasius

He deposed the Bishop of Rome and appointed an Arian one, so they told Pope Athanasius, you are on your own now, the world is against you, he replied and I am against the world



#### Abba Anthony- Father of all



Though a monk, was a great support to Pope Athanasius
P Athanasius saw him as his Father
He wrote his biography, which

became best seller of the time

It was a main factor in the conversion of St Augustine

P Athanasius kept the scarf of St Anthony when he died St Anthony and St Pachomius were great support to him
Arius said : look St Anthony achieved holiness through his own efforts

St Anthony went to Alexandria , to say I am what I am , only through the grace of Jesus

St Anthony – amazing balance He is able to live in total seclusion for 10 yrs, and came out peaceful and relaxed Yet will not hesitate to go to Alex twice, 2<sup>nd</sup> time to support the confessors, and he wished to be martyred, but God will not allow

#### St Pachomius



A pagan, who converted to Christianity through the love that was offered to him by the Christians when he was conscripted in the Roman army- the Lord's worked in him and them

After the end of persecution (Pope Peter the seal of the martyrs ), people went into monasticism in large numbers – 311 AD

He was the first in the world to organise a community of thousands, spread across 9 monasteries, and one convent-Koinonia, a big family Divided each monastery to

houses, each house had a Lead and an assistant. A sizeable group joined him from Alexandria, who could not speak Coptic. Only Greek. Instant translation of his sermons went on all the time


 2 conferences a year, one in Easter and the other after Easter.

Got involved even at 95!

St Anthony was 95 yrs when St Pachomios died.

He told the brothers who visited :

"Abba Horosios has become the Father of Koinonia. He is the new Israsel., who sees God with his internal and external eyes, follow him " Then sent a letter to St Athanasios "To the athlete in Christ".

Please encourage the monks to submit to Abba Horosios


"Pray for us O our unquenchable light, source of intelligence and boast of the saints" The monks met Pope Athanasios and went back to St Anthony, but at 95, he went in seclusion to the inner mountain

St Anthony was asked , why did you not establish a Koinonia ? , I wasn't given the gift. I have anchorites who I guide, but St Pachomios did a first by establishing the community life
