Christianity in Egypt post Chalcedon

- The emperor appointed a rival Pope on Egypt and gave him the administrative role of ruling Egypt,
- A wave of persecution carried on for almost 2 centuries between the Political parallel leader and the Copts

- While Pope Sawiris was in Exile in Egypt for over 20 years, Pope
 Theodosios was also in exile for almost 30 years in Asia Minor.
- However the two Popes were corresponding and of the same faith

- P Benjamin only came out of hiding when the became clear that Amr has fully occupied Egypt
- "Verily in all the lands we have taken, I have never seen a man of God like this man
- He was excellent of speech, calm and dignified- God's Grace to His servants
- Amr asked for his prayer, and he did

The Popes carried the brunt of sufferings

- God put us apostles on display, like those condemned to die in the arena, we have been made a spectacle to all human beings
- The Islamic armies were forever in need of more money, the Pope of the day was considered the one to collect money from his flock

God saved the church from a nasty man

-Al Asbagh, was about to take power from Abd Al Azziz, he taxed the monks, put financial demands on bishops, spat on the icon of St Mary carrying baby Jesus. He became feverish in the night, only became conscious to tell that he was bound in chains, and brought naked before Christ enthroned in his glory, he fell into coma again and died in the morning

Pope Mark 2nd

- Peaceful time for 2 consecutive Popes, built churches, renovated St Mina's Pilgrimage church
- Started businesses to pay the taxes required, Vineyards, Mills, and oil presses
- 2 Businessmen acted as a go between the church and the state, one of them was saweris!

The gates of hell shall not prevail against God's church, The churches enemies are defeated and the church is rescued

Saeed Ibn Kateb Al Farghani

- A brilliant engineer, in Ibn Tolon's era (880)
- Built a reservoir, connected fresh water to the royal palace, Ibn Tolon came to the site to inspect. There were a heap of stones, his horse stumbled over the stones, and he fell
- So he put Saeed in prison. The harsh middle ages

- While in prison, he got to know that Ibn Tolon is planning to build a huge mosque, it would require 300 columns to keep the roof. Surely, the columns would come from knocking down a large number of churches
- He made a model of a mosque from leather, another ingenious design that required, only 2 columns which were built from stones

- The design was applied in Europe 200 yrs later, building a large structure with no supporting columns
- Ibn Tolon liked the design, the mosque was built. Then came the day of the grand opening

- The same principle of designing a large building with no columns was applied by Christopher Wren when he designed the great Naval college in Greenwich in 1750ADHe was criticised, you can't design such a large building with no columns
- He was sure of what he was doing, to appease them, he put 2 columns at the entrance of the hall
- But at the grand opening, people noticed at once that there were 3 inches difference between the columns and the roof, in other words, the columns were decorative only and were not needed to support the ceiling
- Saeed did all this 1000 years before

- This courtiers said, you cannot walk shoulder to shoulder with a Christian opening the mosque
- He called Saeed, either you convert to Islam or I will kill you
- He kept the faith and was martyred

Thank God the harshness of the middle ages and the persecution on the church has lessened, nevertheless, the difficulties that face Christians exist in Egypt and Syria

- 20 yrs ago Saudi was a very strict Muslem country. No churches were allowed
- My brother in Law was working in Saudi, my niece was in 1st yr university, she travelled to Saudi to visit her Dad
- She was found a cassette tape with Christian songs, the tape was confiscated, and she was stripped by female police officers and searched in case she had any further Christian material

- A friend was working in Saudi, he brought a whole box of prayer books with him .As a blessing he also put the coverings cloth of that was around the relics of St Mecorius Abu Sefain. Copts met together in private flats to pray
- In the airport, he was asked by a suspecting police officer, get the keys out of your pocket and open the case. Searching the case, the books would have been confiscated, there was a real possibility of him losing his job and being deported to Egypt

- The most unexpected happened
- Another officer appeared, ordered my friend, put the keys back in your pocket
- He then told the searching officer, I know this man well
- My friend said I have never seen that officer
- The searched bags were marked clearly after they were searched
- As my friend went through customs, another officer commented this bag has not been searched
- The officer who accompanied my friend said, I know him, I can guarantee him
- The protecting officer took my friend through customs, and then disappeared, who was He ??
